Court of Appeals obtaining Case No. 2015-002412; as well, on Rehearing Warranted Remand per se S.C. Court of Appeals, again The 16th Judicial Circuit Court of Common Pleas defaulted by eluding the matter and Denying Appellant again Access To The Courts Pursuant to S.C. Codes § 24-27-100 to 24-27-150. The Circuit Court again opted to disregard the Statutory provision of S.C. Codes § 24-27-100 to 24-27-150. Designed to provide Access To The Courts for Indigent Prisoners.

However The Chief Circuit Judge John C. Hayes III overlooked in both the initial Rule To Show Cause the requirement of providing Prisoner Trust Fund Balances to determine if a prisoner qualifies to proceed and have funds deducted from his/her account as funds become available.. The Chief Circuit Judge not once Denied Appellant Rights To Court. Yet several interims in unrelated matter no mentioned here in instance. Yet on record again The Chief Judge unconsiderable of SWORN AFFIDAVITS provided when the prisoner is unable to have such trust fund document available a SWORN AFFIDAVIT under penalty of Perjury as Well

Notorized Under Penalty of Perjury is substantial & stronger than any means of a document from the prisons. Which under abnormal circumstances. Were the prisoner is being impeded of receiving such document from the appointed administrative agent. 





Plaintiff submitted to the Court a Summons and Complaint as above captioned. He also requested that he be allowed proceed in forma pauperis. The undersigned denied his request to proceed in forma pauperis on November 12, 2015. From this denial, Plaintiff appealed.

The Court of Appeals remanded this matter to this Court with directions that the Court consider "whether Appellant [Plaintiff] should be permitted to file this action and make payments from his inmate Trust account as provided in Section 24-27-100."<sup>1</sup>

A review of Plaintiff's paperwork reveals that he has not complied with Section 24-27-100, S. C. Code of Laws, 1976, as amended, as he did not submit a certified copy of his trust account at the time the Complaint was filed. The record at this point is silent as to whether he does nor does not have a trust account as Plaintiff submitted nothing at the time of filing addressing the existence or non-existence of a trust account.

It should be noted that Plaintiff did not rely on the provisions of Section 24-27-100, S.C. Code of Laws at the time of the filing of his Complaint. His request to proceed in forma pauperis was predicated solely on his assertion that he did not have the funds available to pay the



costs of filing and service "in this present matter." The caption of his request is "Motion and Affidavit to Proceed In Forma Pauperis." (Emphasis Added)

Therefore, the Court cannot allow Plaintiff to file this action pursuant to Section 24-27-100, S.C. Code of Laws, 1976, as amended.

Therefore, Plaintiff's request to proceed in forma pauperis is again Denied.

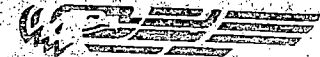

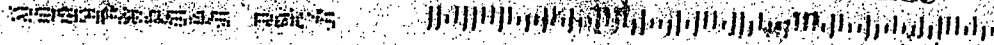
