Dear Mr. Powell:

Upon reviewing your record on appeal, the following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and must be corrected in their entirety within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or your record on appeal may not be considered:

- The binding does not comply with Rule 267(d), SCACR. You have provided copies of the record on appeal that are loosely placed in three-ring binders, and documents are stapled separately in the upper left corner. The record on appeal should be bound as a single document. The title page for the record on appeal should be the first page of the original and each copy. The cover of the record on appeal shall be of a material not less than 50 pound weight and not glassine. The cover does not comply with Rule 267(e), SCACR.
- If you would like to pick up the copies to have them properly bound, you may do so within ten days. At the end of the ten day period, the copies will be discarded.
