

ORDER

Appellant has filed a notice of appeal from the master-in-equity's oral ruling denying Appellant's Rule 60(b), SCRCP and Rule 62(b), SCRCP motions. Appellant stated a "written order has yet to be issued" and explained the master "directed Respondent's counsel to prepare a simple order denying the motion." Because the master has not filed his written order, there has been no final decision. *See* Rule 58(a), SCRCP (stating no order is final until it is written and entered). Pursuant to Rule 201(a) of the South Carolina Rules of Appellate Procedure, an "[a]ppel may be taken, as provided by law, from any final judgment, appealable order or decision." Because there has not yet been a final decision, this appeal is dismissed.¹ The remittitur will be sent as required by Rule 221(b), SCACR.



FOR THE COURT

¹ This court declines to act on the petition for writ of supersedeas. *See State v. Hill*, 314 S.C. 330, 444 S.E.2d 255 (1994) (explaining "a writ of supersedeas is only available where there is an appealable order"). This court will act on any supersedeas filed along with a notice of appeal of a final, appealable order.
