## ORDER

Appellant appeals from an order of the Administrative Law Court (ALC) reversing and remanding the case to the South Carolina Department of Employment and Workforce for further proceedings. Respondents have filed a motion to dismiss this appeal, arguing the order on appeal is an interlocutory order. Appellant filed a return opposing Respondents' motion.

Section 1-23-610(A)(1) of the South Carolina Code (Supp. 2015) provides judicial review may only be sought after a final decision of the ALC. *See also Charlotte-Mecklenburg Hosp. Auth. v. S.C. Dep't of Health & Env'tl. Control*, 387 S.C. 265, 266, 692 S.E.2d 894 (2010) ("[J]udicial review may only be sought from a final decision of the ALC."). Because the ALC reversed and remanded this case to the South Carolina Department of Employment and Workforce, the order was not a final decision. Accordingly, this Court dismisses this case as not immediately appealable.
