The Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA) requires, in some instances, patient authorization before a medical provider may disclose protected health information. However, the HIPAA Privacy Rule does not apply in workers' compensation cases (45 CFR 164.512(l)) and permits medical providers to disclose protected health information to entities involved in the workers' compensation system without the individual's authorization. The HIPAA Rule works in conjunction with §42-15-80 and §42-15-95 of the S.C. Code of Laws and Rule 67-1301 of the South Carolina Workers' Compensation Commission which provides that there is no patient/physician privilege precluding the production of existing medical records in workers' compensation cases.


