MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME
IN WHICH TO FILE THE INITIAL BRIEF OF APPELLANT
AND DESIGNATION OF MATTER

Counsel for appellant respectfully requests an extension of thirty (30) days, **until December 7, 2016**, in which to file the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a third request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The initial brief of appellant and designation of matter are due to be filed with the Court today. The Court has granted counsel two previous extensions.
2. Counsel for appellant respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the number of extensions previously

Counsel filed reply of the return to the motion to hold appeal in abeyance and motion to remand for reconstruction of post-conviction relief hearing or the granting of a new trial in the case of Quincy McCants v. State of South Carolina with the Supreme Court on October 14, 2016. Counsel filed the motion to hold appeal in abeyance and motion to remand for reconstruction of post-conviction relief hearing or the granting of a new trial in the case of Quincy McCants v. State of South Carolina with the Supreme Court on September 21, 2016. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Reggie Pinkney v. State of South Carolina with the Supreme Court on September 14, 2016.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.

5. Counsel for the Attorney General's office consents to this request shown by signature below.

WHEREFORE, the undersigned counsel would respectfully request a thirty day extension, **December 7, 2016**, in which to file the initial brief of appellant and designation of


matter in this case based upon the above exigent circumstances. Counsel requests that time limits for filing the brief be held in abeyance pending a ruling on this motion.
