I appreciate the Courts patience regarding this matter.

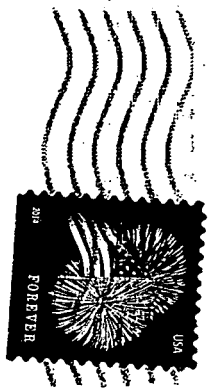
