MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME

and the order in which counsel attempts to manage his caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.



Counsel filed reply of the return to the motion to hold appeal in abeyance and motion to remand for reconstruction of post-conviction relief hearing or the granting of a new trial in the case of Quincy McCants v. State of South Carolina with the Supreme Court on October 14, 2016. Counsel filed the motion to hold appeal in abeyance and motion to remand for reconstruction of post-conviction relief hearing or the granting of a new trial in the case of Quincy McCants v. State of South Carolina with the Supreme Court on September 21, 2016. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Reggie Pinkney v. State of South Carolina with the Supreme Court on September 14, 2016.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay. Counsel intends to continue to work on the cases with more than three extensions first so that the caseload will hopefully become more manageable in the near future, and less extensions will need to be requested.

5. Counsel for the Attorney General's office consents to this request as shown by signature below.




