Dear Mr. Lowery:

This letter is in response to your letter to the Court dated November 7, 2016. You asked the Court to allow you to file an appellant's initial brief that is over 25 pages. However, you have already filed an appellant's initial brief. The page limit for the initial brief, pursuant to Rule 208(B)(5) of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules, is 50 pages for the primary brief (i.e. the appellant's initial brief). The 25-page limit would apply to a brief you would file in response to the respondent's initial brief.

Further, the Court received your appellant's initial brief on September 29, 2016. It is unclear why you filed a subsequent brief on November 9, 2016. If you wish to amend the appellant's initial brief you filed on September 29, you must serve and file a motion asking the Court to allow you to amend your brief.
