
Pursuant to *In Re Stays of Execution in Capital Cases*, 471 S.E.2d 140 (S.C. 1996), and the Court's Order of September 25, 2014, please consider this letter as a status report to Court Administration regarding this capital-PCR case and the current stay of execution concerning Petitioner Brad Sigmon. This letter was due on: November 18, 2016.

The parties are awaiting the Supreme Court's decision in *Robertson v. State*, S.C. Appellate Case No. 2012-205909 (oral argument held October 8, 2015), since it is likely to provide guidance in Sigmon's case. Judge Nicholson held a hearing on August 12, 2015, on the State's Motion for Summary Judgment. He has taken the matter under advisement, pending the Court's decision in *Robertson*.

I will file another status report with Court Administration, as is required per *In Re Stays*, in another sixty (60) days, which will be due on: January 17, 2017.
