- The initial brief is not accompanied by a designation of matter to be included in the record on appeal.
- The document has not been timely filed. A motion to allow the late filing will have to be made.
- The content of the appellant's initial brief is incorrectly organized. Pursuant to Rule 208(b)(1), SCACR. It must contain under appropriate headings and in the order indicated by the rule the following: Table of Contents and cases, statement of issues on appeal, statement of the case, argument and conclusion. You must file an amended appellant's initial brief, correcting all deficiencies.
