



ORDER

On September 2, 2016, this court dismissed this appeal, holding the circuit court's order denying Appellant's motion for protection is not immediately appealable. Appellant has now filed a petition for rehearing, arguing the order is immediately appealable pursuant to section 14-3-330(2) of the South Carolina Code (1976).

After careful consideration of the petition, Respondent's return, and the underlying order, we adhere to the order of dismissal and hold the order denying Appellant's motion for protection is not immediately appealable pursuant to section 14-3-330.
