

**SECOND MOTION FOR ENLARGEMENT OF TIME
TO FILE AND SERVE INITIAL BRIEF**

Appellant herewith moves for a thirty (30) day enlargement of time for the submission of their initial brief. The brief is presently scheduled for submission on December 2, 2016. Appellant requests that the submission be rescheduled for January 2, 2016. 

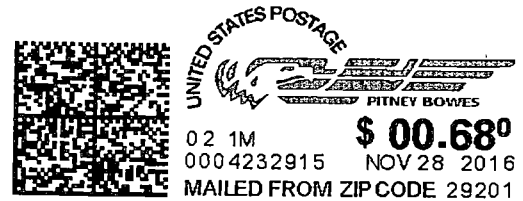
