Dear Chauncey and Janice Barnwell:

Upon reviewing your amended record on appeal and appellants' final brief, the following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or your appeal will be dismissed:

- The accompanying proofs of service are not in compliance with the SCACR. Your proof of service should be substantially in the format shown by Form 7 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR. The proofs of service are dated for the initial service of these documents, not for service of the amended document. The proofs of service must include the case caption and case number.
- The covers do not comply with Rule 267(e), SCACR. Glassine is not permitted. You must remove the black plastic and glassine covers and cover the spines with heavy tape.

- The documents are not accompanied by the required certificate of counsel.
