

ORDER

Appellant has appealed the circuit court's order granting Respondent's motion to quash deposition notices pursuant to Rule 30(a)(2), SCRCP. After careful consideration of Appellant's appealability memorandum and the underlying order, we find the underlying order is not immediately appealable. *See Lowndes Products, Inc. v. Brower*, 262 S.C. 431, 205 S.E.2d 184 (1979) (holding an order refusing to compel the taking of depositions and the production of records by a party is not immediately appealable). Accordingly, this appeal is dismissed.
