

ORDER

Appellant has served and filed a notice of appeal from two orders of the Department of Public Safety, which suspend and remove Appellant from the South Carolina Highway Patrol Rotation List. Appellant has also filed a petition for supersedeas, asking this court to stay the suspension. Because the administrative law court has not issued a final decision in this matter, this court lacks jurisdiction to consider the appeal. *See* S.C. Code Ann. § 1-23-600 (Supp. 2016) (setting forth the jurisdiction of the administrative law court); S.C. Code Ann. § 1-23-610 (Supp. 2016) ("For judicial review of a final decision of an administrative law judge, a notice of appeal by an aggrieved party must be served and filed with the court of appeals as provided in the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules."). Accordingly, this court declines to consider the petition for supersedeas, and this appeal is dismissed. The remittitur will be sent as provided in Rule 221, SCACR.
