MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME
IN WHICH TO FILE THE PETITION FOR WRIT OF
CERTIORARI AND APPENDIX

Counsel respectfully requests a **final extension of thirty (30) days until January 11, 2017**, in which to file the petition for writ of certiorari and appendix in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a third request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The petition for writ of certiorari and appendix is due to be served and filed with the Court today.
2. Counsel respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the number of extensions previously granted

and the order in which counsel attempts to manage his caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.

Counsel filed the petition for rehearing in the case of The State v. Donte Samar Brown with the Court of Appeals on November 17, 2016. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Edward Tyler v. The State of South Carolina in the Supreme Court on November 17, 2016. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Albert Owens v. The State of South Carolina in the Supreme Court on October 31, 2016. Counsel filed the petition for rehearing in the case of The State v. Daniel Martinez Herrera with the Court of Appeals on October 27, 2016. Counsel filed the reply brief pursuant to White v. State in the case of Daniel Hamrick v. The State of South Carolina in the Supreme Court on October 27, 2016. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Deitrich Funchess v. The State of South Carolina in the Supreme Court on October 26, 2016.


4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay. Counsel intends to continue to work on the cases with more than three extensions first so that the caseload

5. Counsel for the Attorney General's office consents to this request as shown by signature below.


