INDICTMENT

At a Court of General Sessions, convened December 2016, the Grand Jurors of Berkeley County present upon their oath:

**ASSAULT & BATTERY, 1ST DEGREE**

That in Berkeley County, South Carolina, on or about April 15, 2016, the Defendant, Edward D. Skowronski, did commit an unlawful act of injury upon the victim, [REDACTED] West, and the act either: (1) involved nonconsensual touching of the private parts of the victim, either under or above clothing, with lewd and lascivious intent; or (2) occurred during the commission of a robbery, burglary, kidnapping, or theft; or (3) the defendant offered or attempted to injure the victim with the present ability to do so, and the act was accomplished by means likely to produce death or great bodily injury; or occurred during the commission of a robbery, burglary, kidnapping, or theft. This is in violation of Section 16-3-600(C)(1) of the South Carolina Code of Laws (1976) as amended.

Against the peace and dignity of the State, and contrary to the statute in such case made and provided.
