That on March 19, 2014 in the county of Aiken, the Defendant, one Todd Virgil Brown did, with malice and aforethought intentionally cause the death of the Victim, Lacey Marie Parker, by shooting her multiple times with an unknown type of handgun. This act was aggravated in that it occurred while the Defendant was also committing the act of burglary. This incident took place at 548 Pine Street, Warrenville, SC. This being in violation of the South Carolina Code of Laws as amended. The Defendant was implicated by an eyewitness.
