1. The petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in this case are due to be served and filed today.



Counsel filed the initial brief of appellate and designation of matter in State v. Eric Wright with this Court on October 25, 2012. The petition for writ

of certiorari in Kenji Manning v. State was filed with the Supreme Court on October 22, 2012. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in Vincent Neumon v. State in the Supreme Court on October 15, 2012. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the Supreme Court in David Fowler v. State on October 11, 2012. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in Tippy Marie Retana v. State in the Supreme Court on October 10, 2012. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in Kendall Green v. State in the Supreme Court on October 5, 2012. Counsel had oral argument in the Supreme Court in the case of Ernest Pressley v. State on October 2, 2012.


