

ORDER

Respondent has filed a motion to compel Appellant to include all matters designated by Respondent in the record on appeal and to strike portions of the record on appeal, which were not presented to the lower court. Appellant filed a return, and Respondent filed a reply.

After careful consideration, the motion is granted. Within thirty days of this order, Appellant shall serve an amended record on appeal that (1) contains a complete copy of Respondent's Complaint and Certification, (2) contains copies of the signed and filed orders from the circuit court, and (3) excludes the exhibits to the April 28, 2016 memorandum. Appellant shall also exclude all references to the exhibits to the April 28, 2016 memorandum in his briefs.
