MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME


1. The petition for writ of certiorari to the Court of Appeals is due to be served and filed with the Court today.

Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. Daryl Snow with the Court of Appeals on November 12, 2015. Counsel had an oral argument in the case of State v. Gerald Barrett before the Court of Appeals on November 10, 2015. Counsel filed a return to petition for writ of certiorari in the case of State v. Noah Mumford with the Supreme Court on October 29, 2015. Counsel filed a petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Noah Mumford v. State with the Supreme Court on October 29, 2015. Counsel filed a petition for rehearing in the case of State v. William Donald Bolt with the Court of Appeals on October 22, 2015. Counsel had an oral argument in the case of State v. Jason Allen Johnson before the Supreme Court on October 20, 2015.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.
5. Counsel for the Attorney General's office has been informed of this request.


