dated April 27, 2016, David A. Collins, counsel for the Respondents, was suspended from the practice of law.





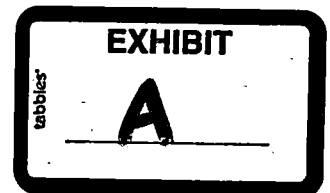

AFFIDAVIT OF DAVID B. POWELL

PERSONALLY APPEARED before me David B. Powell, who, being duly sworn,
deposes and states as follows:

1. I am over the age of 21 and competent to give this affidavit.
2. I am the Respondent in the above-referenced Appellate matter, a fact that I only became aware of on Friday, December 9, 2016.
3. In the underlying case I was represented by David A. Collins, Esquire.
4. It was my understanding from David Collins that Sun Trust had 30 days from the date its Motion for Summary Judgment was denied on May 3, 2016, in which to file an appeal and that if it did not appeal the Judge's ruling the case was ended.
5. David Collins never contacted me in any way or at any time after we discussed the outcome of the Summary Judgment hearing so I assumed that the case was over and that the



lien that had been placed against my property located at 1001 Ocean Blvd., Isle of Palms, SC 28451 had been removed as was ordered by Judge Markley Dennis.

6. On November 18, 2016, I listed this property for sale with Jeff Cook Real Estate.

7. On December 8, 2016 I accepted an offer to sell said property.

8. On December 9, 2016, I was having a conversation with my girlfriend Julianna McQueen in which she asked me if I had any paperwork regarding the lien removal by Sun Trust. I explained to Julianna that the last time I spoke with David A. Collins, Esquire he advised me that we won our Motion for Summary Judgment and Sun Trust lost its Motion for Reconsideration. He further stated that Sun Trust had 30 days from the date of the judge's decision in which to file an appeal. He told me he would let me know if Sun Trust appealed. I never heard a word from him so in my mind the case was over.

9. Also on December 9, 2016, Julianna, recalling the previous lost sale of this home due to the Sun Trust lien that I never knew existed, decided to search the Charleston County Clerk of Courts website to make certain the case was closed. It was at this time that I learned that a Notice of Appeal had been filed by Sun Trust on July, 20, 2016.

10. Upon learning on December 9, 2016, of Sun Trusts Notice of Appeal, I immediately called the mobile telephone number of my attorney, David A. Collins to find out how it was possible that an Appeal had been filed in my case and yet he never bothered to tell me. I received his voice mail and left a message.

11. I then contacted the law office of David A. Collins. I was informed by the person that answered the phone that David A. Collins had been suspended from the practice of law on July 20, 2016, and no longer worked at the office.

12. Immediately after I hung up with his former office, David A. Collins returned my telephone call and informed me that he has been suspended from the practice of law because he “got involved with some shady characters” and “did some things I shouldn’t have.” After we got off of the telephone he sent me a text containing the contact information for the Receiver appointed by the Supreme Court, Peyre Lumpkin.

13. I then immediately contacted the office of Peyre Lumpkin regarding my case and was advised that a letter was sent addressed to me and my ex-wife at 273 Forest Trail, Isle of Palms, SC regarding the suspension of our lawyer David A. Collins from the practice of law. I advised the girl that I spoke with that I had never received a letter. I also advised her that I had not lived at that address since 2008, and that my ex-wife had not lived there for over 2 years. She advised me that she knew that we had never received the letter because it was returned to her office. I then asked her if she or anyone in her office had even attempted to locate us to which she replied “no” and explained that her office is very busy and beyond the initial letter no attempt is made to locate people in our situation.

14. Thereafter, I was advised by Atty. Lumpkin’s office that if I wanted my file I would need to sign an release, have my signature notarized and provide a copy of my driver’s license, all of which I did via fax on December 9, 2016. However, Atty. Lumpkin later that day advised me that while he would accept the faxed copy of my license, he needed me to mail him the original release before he would release my file to me. I mailed the original release the same day.

15. As of today’s date I do not have a copy of my file related to this case from the Receiver’s office.

16. Realizing that it would be quite some time before I would receive my file from the Receiver and that I am under a very limited time frame to resolve this matter, I contacted my friend, Kim Lagrand, a paralegal at Womble Carlyle Sandridge & Rice, LLP to ask her where I should go for help with this matter. Kim suggested her boss Henry E. Grimbball, Esquire was someone that could handle this matter for me.

17. It is my understanding that Kim spoke with Henry on December 9th and that she and he made a telephone call to Sean Foerster, the attorney for Sun Trust in an attempt to determine the status of the Appeal and what if anything had been done to contact me.

18. Attorney Foerster provided Henry and Kim with copies of the Appellate filings to date which show that a Notice of Appeal was filed in this case on July 20, 2016, and that my lawyer David A. Collins was copied on the pleading.

19. The file also contains a letter dated August 2, 2016 from David A. Collins to Sean Foerster, Esquire informing him that his law license was suspended on July 20, 2016, and advising him that Peyre Lumpkin was appointed by the Supreme Court as the Receiver of his cases. In the letter David Collins not only gives Peyre Lumpkin and incorrect address for me, he cautions him not to contact me stating I may have already retained another lawyer.


20. I never received any letter from David A. Collins informing me that he had been suspended on July 20, 2016, oddly enough, the same day this Appeal was filed by Sun Trust.

21. The file provided by Sean Foerster, Esquire, also contains an August 16, 2016, letter from the South Carolina Supreme Court to me advising that David A. Collins has been suspended from the practice of law and that I need to retain other counsel or I will be presumed to be proceeding pro-se. This letter is addressed to me at 273 Forest Trail, Isle of Palms, SC 29451. I have not lived at this address since July, 2015.

22. I have put a change of address in with the United States Post Office every time I have moved. My current address is The Riviera, 1425 Long Grove Drive, Apt. 101, Mt. Pleasant, SC 29464

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
