MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME  
IN WHICH TO FILE THE PETITION FOR  
WRIT OF CERTIORARI AND APPENDIX

Counsel for Boyd Rashaeen Evans respectfully requests a **final thirty (30) day extension, until January 20, 2017**, in which to file the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a third request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix are due to be served and filed with the Court today. The Court has granted counsel two previous extensions.
2. Counsel for Boyd Rashaeen Evans respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the

number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage her caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.

3. Counsel is filing the initial brief of appellant in the case of State v. Antwan Adams with the Court of Appeals today, December 21, 2016. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari in the case of James William McKinney, Jr. v. State with the Court of Appeals on December 16, 2016. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari in the case of Chad Hollingsworth v. State with the Court of Appeals on December 7, 2016. Counsel filed the Brief of Respondent in the case of Letron Davis v. State with this Court on December 5, 2016. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari in the case of Roshod Baker v. State with this Court on November 23, 2016. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant in the case of State v. David Alan White with the Court of Appeals on November 21, 2016. Counsel filed the opposition to the state's motion to dismiss the motion for resentencing in the case of State v. Ronald Mack in Williamsburg County on November 5, 2016.


4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.


5. Counsel for the Attorney General's office has been informed of this request as shown by signature below.




