## ORDER

The petition for a writ of certiorari that has been filed in this matter contains various documents including letters, an order, a notice of scheduling, a roster and e-mails. These documents are not properly included in the petition. Rule 242(d) of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR) (specifying the content of the petition).

Further, the appendix that petitioner has filed fails to contain the final brief of the respondent and fails to contain all of the materials contained in the record on appeal and supplemental record on appeal as required by Rule 242(e), SCACR.

<sup>1</sup> The petition for a writ of certiorari appears to indicate that Howard W. Charpia and Jody E. Charpia are seeking review of the decision of the Court of Appeals. The documents that have been filed, however, are only signed by Howard Charpia. Since Howard Charpia is not licensed to practice law in South Carolina, he cannot make filing on behalf of Jody Charpia. Therefore, the title of this matter reflects that Howard Charpia is the sole petitioner before this Court. *See* Rule 267(b), SCACR ("The original of a document or paper filed by a party or his attorney shall be signed by the party or the attorney.").

Additionally, the appendix contains documents other than those specified by Rule 242(e), SCACR.

Accordingly, this matter is dismissed under Rule 260(a), SCACR.
