

WHEREFORE the appellants and respondent move for dismissal of the appeal with prejudice and for such other relief as the court deems just, prudent, and proper.



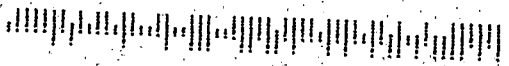
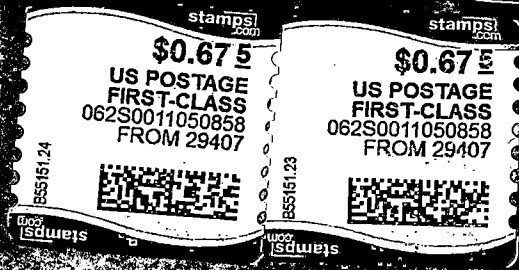
