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## ORDER


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After this Court affirmed the judgment of the circuit court in this appeal, Respondent Florence County and Respondent Pee Dee Land Company each filed motions for costs under Rule 222, SCACR. Neither Appellant Fowler nor Appellant Joye filed a return to either of these motions, and the Clerk of this Court granted the motions awarding costs against appellants.


Appellants have now filed a motion seeking to compel the Florence County Finance Director to pay the costs awarded to Respondent Pee Dee Land Company. Respondent Florence County has filed a return asserting that appellants should be required to personally pay the costs that have been awarded. Appellants have filed a reply.


This Court does clarify that the award of costs to both Respondent Florence County and Respondent Pee Dee Land Company shall be paid from the personal


funds of the appellants and not from any funds of Florence County. Accordingly, the motion to compel is denied.
