4. Facts in controversy: Employer/Carrier deny that claimant suffered any injury by accident arising out of the course and scope of his employment. Claimant has a very long history of treatment for his back, neck, right shoulder and right hand. Claimant has a significant history of claims for injuries to the alleged body parts including 12 prior personal injury claims. Claimant was seen over nineteen times at the Emergency Rooms of GHS and St. Francis Hospital in the year prior to the alleged accident seeking narcotics and pain medications for chronic low back pain, left foot pain, and right shoulder and hand pain. Claimant's medical records prior to the alleged date of accident document missing teeth. Claimant worked at the job site until the work was completed. He never reported any work related injury to the employer until the job ended and he retained counsel to file a notice of claim. Claimant's original counsel has been relieved and claimant is proceeding pro se.
5. Legal issues involved: Whether Claimant suffered any accident during his brief employment with Hire Quest. Whether the alleged injuries are causally related to his employment; Whether Claimant has met his burden of proving his alleged injuries are causally related to his 7/4/2014 injury; Whether claimant is entitled to medical treatment under the Act.
6. Unusual aspects: Claimant is Pro Se and is incarcerated at the Greenville County Detention Center. Claimant will need an Order of Transport to appear at the hearing on August 28, 2015.





Dear Commissioner McCaskill:

Please allow this to serve as the Employer/Carrier's response to Mr. McCall's repeated motions to reopen the record, reconvene the hearing, or reconsider your decision. The primary objection Mr. McCall asserts is that I failed to obtain documents from a free clinic on his behalf. First, as you advised Mr. McCall, he bears the burden of proving entitlement to benefits. Second, attached please find a response from the facility Mr. McCall references in his various motions. As you will note, this facility indicated they had no record of Mr. McCall as a patient.

There is absolutely no basis upon which to reopen the record in this case. Mr. McCall had the Employer and Carrier's APA Submissions and Prehearing Brief from at least April 1, 2015 until the hearing held before you on August 28, 2015. Given his prolific correspondence to the Commission both before and after the hearing in this case, it is apparent he has a lot of time to work on his case. If there were records missing, he was given ample time and opportunity to bring this to your attention prior to or at the hearing on August 28, 2015.

Finally, Mr. McCall has requested that my office provide him with a copy of the hearing transcript. I cannot copy the transcript as that would deprive the Court Reporter of her work product. I am bringing this to the Commission's attention as I do not know the Commission's position on providing hearing transcripts to pro se claimants. It is patently unfair to my client to pay for Mr. McCall's hearing transcript and we will not consent to do so. Mr. McCall's endless motions and correspondence have cost my client considerably in litigation expenses. If Mr. McCall files any further frivolous motions, I will be forced to request that attorney's fees be assessed against him.



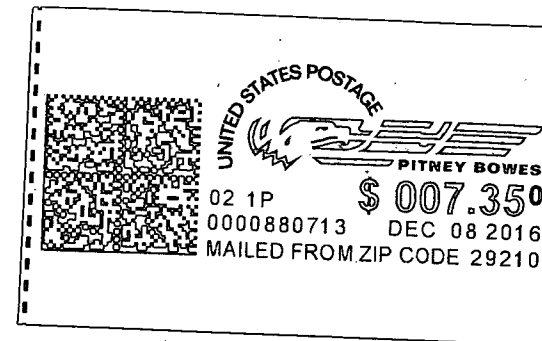
