

Dear Ms. Dunlap:

I received your letter, dated and postmarked November 17, 2016 on November 27, 2016, following vacation. Let me offer the following information:

Transcripts are prepared pursuant to written requests only. A deposit for the estimated cost of the transcript must accompany each request. For transcripts done by me, all deposits must be in the form of a money order or certified check payable to: Vivian H. Cross, Circuit Court Reporter. Transcripts are then prepared in order of receipt.

Reviewing my notes, this hearing will be somewhere around 35 pages. This may vary up or down depending on the amount of 'lull' time in the hearing -- that is, the amount of off record conferences, etc. that took place and the general pace of the hearing. Original transcripts are billed at a per page rate of \$3.25 per page plus postage for mailing. Therefore, the deposit that is required for this transcript is \$120.00. This is an estimate only. 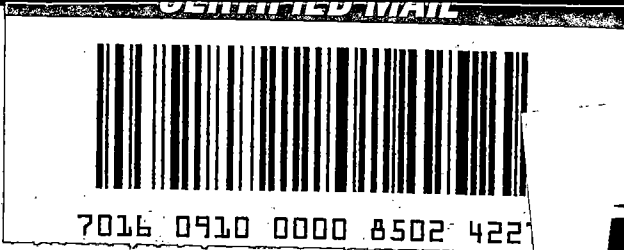
