ORDER

Respondent/Appellant Porthemos Curry's motion for leave to file a motion with the circuit court for relief from judgment under Rule 60(b), SCRCP, is granted. Counsel for Respondent/Appellant is ordered to file the motion with the circuit court within twenty days of the date of this order and provide an update to the clerk of this court every thirty days thereafter. This appeal will be held in abeyance pending the circuit court's resolution of this matter. Because the motion for leave to file the Rule 60(b) motion has been granted and this appeal is being held in abeyance, this court declines to act on the motion to amend the initial briefs. Nothing prevents either party from moving to amend their briefs after the circuit court has ruled on the Rule 60(b) motion.
