Dear Steve, Larry, and Jo Anne,

Now that the above case is finally and at long last concluded and thankfully and justly in my favor, I would like to conclude and complete all the details and follow-up as soon as possible, thus this letter. With my father's death and my mother in poor condition, I am attempting to balance many things but am trying to give this the priority it deserves.

As your power support pole and guy wires are still trespassing on my property, this is courteous notice that such must be moved straightaway and the area on which they encroached, must be cleaned up and restored pristinely. We, of course, have been unable to clean the area for the years your equipment was placed there, as I have earlier expressed to you. I think a timetable of 10 days should be sufficient for this task.


We expect no retaliation of course in any form and also hope you will notify my fellow cooperative members and Board of this matter and its results, as they certainly deserve to know. I know I was discussed at Board meetings and I feel my name and payment history along with the trespass should be cleared. I would appreciate and hereby request as a long coop member that you submit to me a detailed billing of what the cooperative has paid in attorneys' fees costs, and all associated costs and expenses with this case from start to finish. I believe I/we have a right to know and this is my official request. It has certainly and unfortunately cost me a lot as well, needlessly.

Thank you all and I shall look for immediate and priority responses from you given the SC Supreme Court's and other courts' ruling, the on-going trespass, and our need to resolve this matter fully. I would be appreciate of prompt payment of my court costs in these proceedings so we can avoid more legal entanglements for my fellow members and for me. I have sent you the amount for the Writ and I will be happy to provide the trial and appeal costs as well so we can conclude rapidly and put this almost-decade old debacle behind us. I continue an excellent Blue Ridge customer,

going on 35 plus years now. I have never received any share for my membership period. How does that work?

I shall look to hear as soon as possible and hope our new year is healthy for us all.

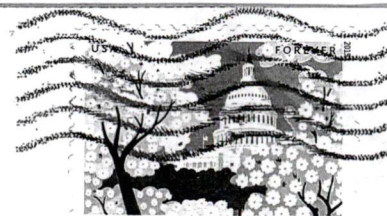
