SPECIFICALLY SET FORTH

1. I just returned to the institution this past Friday afternoon from eye-surgery at MUSC; My eye is still not healed. Prior to this medical matter, I was hospitalized twenty four days with a serious medical emergency and could not be involved in legal research here @ Lieber. I still have a substantial amount of legal research to complete and to assemble my Pro Se brief for submission to this Court; This just has not been possible.

2. We have only three computers here @ Lieber. For some reason, our law library has been packed with over thirty inmates per session and this has presented an accomodation problem for inmates who must use the law library. In my case, it creates a serious access problem, I am sorry to say, however, this problem can not be circumvented via anything I am cognizant of.

I am in sincere hope that your Court has the ability grant me this one additional extension in the amount of forty five (45) days. at which time I will be prepared to submit my Pro Se brief for consideration. Thank you,

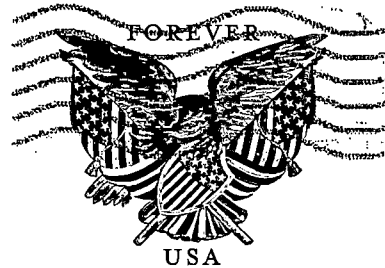
