ORDER

First, Appellant's motion to proceed *in forma pauperis* is granted. Second, we have received Respondent's letter dated January 9, 2017, noting "the case should likely be remanded to the Workers' Compensation Commission to allow the Commission to accept Appellant's Form 30." Unfortunately, this court does not have a mechanism for disposing of the merits of an appeal prior to final briefing.
