
Janet Shander-Horning and Jeff Horning (the "Appellants") filed *Appellants' Motion for (I) Leave to File Rule 60 Motion and (II) Stay of Appeal Pending Determination of Rule 60 Motion* and a supporting brief (together, the "Motion") on January 18, 2017 through the undersigned counsel. The Respondents' deadline to respond to the Motion is January 30, 2017.

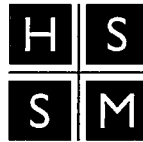

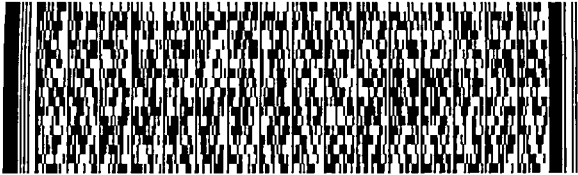
