Please find enclosed a letter from The Court of Appeals dated October 27, 2016, also an Order from the Court of Appeals filed date December 2, 2016.

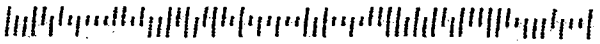

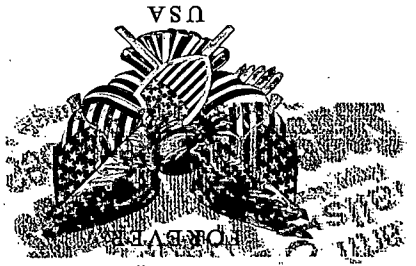
