MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME
IN WHICH TO FILE THE PETITION FOR WRIT OF
CERTIORARI AND APPENDIX

Counsel for Louis Sanders respectfully requests an extension of thirty (30) days in which to file the petition for writ of certiorari and appendix in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a second request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

Lester Mosley, Jr. with the Court of Appeals on December 19, 2016. Counsel filed the Initial Brief of Appellant in the case of The State of South Carolina v. Jermaine D. Grier with the Court of Appeals on December 16, 2016. Counsel filed the Johnson Petition for Writ of Certiorari and the accompanying appendix in the case of Marion Stewart v. The State of South Carolina with this Court on December 12, 2016. Counsel filed the Johnson Petition for Writ of Certiorari and the accompanying appendix in the case of Travarias Walker v. The State of South Carolina with this Court on December 6, 2016.


4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.

5. Counsel for the Attorney General's office has been informed of this request.


WHEREFORE, the undersigned counsel would respectfully request a thirty day extension, in which to file the petition for writ of certiorari and appendix in this case based upon


