**RESPONDENT'S MOTION FOR ENLARGEMENT OF TIME



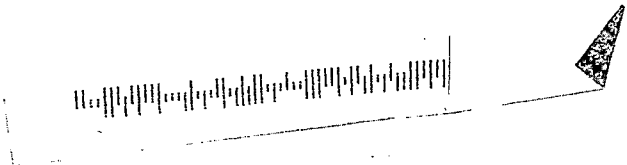


