

## ORDER

---

Appellant has filed a "Motion to Limit the Record on Appeal," which we construe as a motion to strike items from Respondents' designation of matter. Appellant also filed a motion for an extension of time to file the record on appeal, but he subsequently served and filed the record. Respondents thereafter filed a motion to amend the record, seeking the addition of items listed in their designation but excluded from the record and the removal of items they argue were improperly included. Respondents also filed a motion for an extension of time to file their final brief. Appellant's motion to strike and Respondents' motion to amend the record are both granted in part and denied in part. Appellant shall serve and file an amended record on appeal that includes all items designated by the parties except the following: items 1-8 from Appellant's designation of matter and items k and r-dd from Respondents' designation of matter. In addition, Appellant shall not annotate any documents included in the record, and all orders and pleadings must comply with Rule 210(c), SCACR ("When a portion of an order, judgment, decision or pleading is to be included in the Record on Appeal, the entire order, judgment, decision or pleading shall be included in the Record, to include the caption and signature(s); provided, however, that the portion of a pleading showing verification or service shall not be included unless relevant to the appeal."). Both motions for extensions of time are granted. Appellant shall serve and file the amended record within thirty days of entry of this order, and Respondents shall serve and file their final brief within twenty days of service of the amended record.
