§ 16-13-0110(A)

At a Court of General Sessions, convened on AUGUST 2015, the Grand Jurors of Lexington County present upon their oath:

That **Yul Graham** in Lexington County, South Carolina, on or about June 21, 2015, previously having been convicted of at least two offenses for which the term of imprisonment is contingent upon the value of the property involved; did take possession of or carry away, transfer from one person to another or from one area of a store to another; did alter, transfer, or remove the price label or tag; or did transfer from its container to another container or conceal merchandise displayed, held or offered for sale by a store with the intention of depriving the merchant of the possession, use or benefit of the merchandise without paying the full retail value; to wit: frozen foods and trail mix with an estimated value of \$2000 or less from Bi-Lo, located at 2349 Augusta Road, West Columbia, South Carolina, (BI-LO); all in violation of Section 16-13-110 and Section 16-1-57 of the Codes of Law of South Carolina, (1976, as amended)
