



Dear Mr. Cantrell,

I have received your letter dated November 19, 2016, wherein you request the Transcript of Record in the case of Carlton E. Cantrell vs. Aiken County, et al. Upon review of my notes I estimate the transcript will be approximately 10 pages long for an estimated cost of \$39.50, which includes postage and handling. An electronic copy can also be furnished with any official transcript order for an additional \$35, which would total \$74.50. I will waive the electronic copy fee and, of course, postage and handling if you would like only an electronic copy, making the total \$32.50.

If the transcript is smaller than estimated, I will certainly refund your money. Likewise, if it is larger than my estimation, I will either call or write you to let you know of the balance owed.

It is necessary that I receive payment before producing the transcript in the form of a cashier's check or money order made payable to Bethanie Creppon. I cannot accept a personal check. Upon receipt of the funds, I will place your transcript in line for production. By statute, I am allowed 60 days to complete the transcript. If a longer period is needed, I will request an extension and you will be informed by Court Administration, however, I do not believe that will be necessary, nor do I anticipate that it will take the full 60 days to complete the transcript.





This is in regards to the letter received On February 3, 2017 by the Appellant Mr. Cantrell from the Court of Appeals dated January 31, 2017 in regarding the transcript. On November 17 2016, the Appellant Mr. Cantrell received a letter from the court of Appeals Dated November 14, 2016 stating that the notice of appeal had been received. On November 21, 2016; the Appellant Mr. Cantrell sent a letter to the court reporter Bethanie K. Creppon requesting a copie of the transcript and sent a copie to the Court of Appeals, the Court of Administration, and the defendants lawyers, for the hearing conducted on October 10, 2016, before Circuit Court Judge, Doyet Early. On December 3, 2016 Mr. Cantrell received a letter from the Court Reporter Bethanie Creppon , concerning the cost of the transcript and explaining that upon receipt of the funds she would place the transcript in line for production and she had 60Days from that time to complete the transcript. On December 5, 2016 the Appellant Mr. Cantrell Went to his bank First Citizens and requested a money order for 39.50 after receiving the money Order a mistake had been made on the money order so Mr. Cantrell had to go back to the bank And get a new money order and this was on December 7, 2016 it was mailed to the court Reporter that same day and a copie sent to the Court of Appeals , the Court of Administration, And the defendants. On January 20, 2017 the Appellant Mr. Cantrell called the Court of Administration and talked with Mishelle Owens, at the Court of Administration in regards to the transcript and she said that the Court reporter, Bethanie Creppon had received the funds for the transcript around December 8, 2017. 60 days from this date would be February 6, 2016. On February 3 2017 the Appellant Mr. Cantrell received a letter from the Court of Appeals requesting within 10 days to advise the court of the status of the transcript the letter was dated January 31.
