Dear Ms. Meisner:

Upon reviewing your designation of matter, following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and any deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or your appeal will be dismissed:

- The accompanying proof of service is not in compliance with the SCACR. Your proof of service certifies that you "have served a copy of the motion..." Instead, your proof of service must refer specifically to service of the appellant's initial brief and designation of matter.
- The accompanying proof of service is not in compliance with the SCACR. Your proof of service should be substantially in the format shown by Form 7 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR.
- The caption/title does not comply with Rule 267(a), SCACR. Specifically, you must include the case caption on the designation of matter.

- The document is not accompanied by the required certificate of counsel pursuant to Rule 209(c), SCACR.
- The document has not been signed as required by Rule 267(b), SCACR.
