Dear Ms. Kitchings:

This requests an extension of thirty days beyond the current January 20, 2017 date granted to complete tasks involving compilation of the Designated Matter datum required by the Court of Appeals in the appeal process.

My grounds for the extension are due to unexpected complications during the fulfillment of the initial, and timely placed order of the Record on Appeal documents from the appeals court in Columbia, South Carolina.

There were almost three hundred single pages and accompanying datum of signed and dated pages for each order motion or judgment, along with a certification of service pages.

Ms. Elizabeth Clark was assigned the retrieval and compilation responsibility I was told. I checked in with her often regarding the status of her work.

The stack of ten inch long by eight inch wide by two plus inches high was bound with one vertical and one horizontal rubber band, then placed in an over-sized manila envelope with a metal clasp on one end and wrapped multiple times with heavy duty extra wide scotch tape. Inside the envelope, the weighty and formidable stack of papers more than likely slid back and forth and the vertical rubber band split.

Upon arrival I could not easily discard the tape so I opened the unclasped end, and materials spread across the uncovered hard wood floor in the shape of a winding snake. The mass of papers was followed with one split rubber band.

As none of the pages were stapled or clipped it was impossible to recreate the original consecutive order, especially because there were an inordinate number of unsigned and undated papers.

I called the court and they said they were sorry and would reassign the task for the same fee of sixty dollars, plus shipping.

Evidently the Court of Appeals was especially busy as it was about four months to get the reorder. The entire package was intact with sections secured by metal clips at the top.

The reorder arrived January 2, 2017.

I appreciate Ms. Kitchings' cooperation and her staff's dedication to provide these valuable materials.

There was only one particular page missing which had been sent in as a motion and shared with Mr. Chasteen in late November or early December. Ms. Kitchings is allowing me to resubmit a motion of great importance.

It may have been accidentally placed in another file, during this confusing time.

I pray the court approves this request for an extension. I regret my two strokes cause me to miss the correct letter, while typing. I am borrowing a computer, here after, with a voice application called "a Dragon."

There is nothing the matter with my thinking, I simply can't write correctly. However, I am improving, I understand it takes time to get back my coordination.

I faxed my certification and filing fee, followed up with the actual money orders to the Clerk's office.

I am challenged, but not dead yet.

I am duty bound to protect my children in the name of justice and I pray that you can understand.

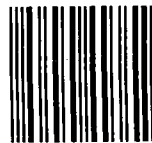
