
Dear Ms. Smith:

Upon reviewing your notice of appeal, the following deficiency or deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and any deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or the appeal will be dismissed:

- The notice of appeal is not accompanied by the order(s) and/or judgment(s) challenged on appeal.
- The notice of appeal fails to include a statement of when you received written notice of entry of the order or judgment from which this appeal is taken.
- The required filing fee has not been submitted. The correct filing fee is \$100.00.
- A proof of service has not been provided. You must serve and file a proof of service substantially in the format shown by Form 7 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR.

- A proof of service showing that a copy has been served on the Administrative Law Court has not been provided as required by Rule 203(b) (6), SCACR.
- An amended notice of appeal must be served and filed. Please review Rule 203, and Form 1 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR, for the correct format.
- We are returning the documents included with your filings, as it is not necessary to provide the material at this time. Please see Rule 210, SCACR, for guidance on when to file the record on appeal with the Court.
- Personal Identifier information must not be included in your appeal. Please see Rule 41.2, SCRCF. **(a) Redaction.** A person filing a document in paper or electronic format shall not include, or will redact where inclusion is necessary, the following personal identifying information. **(1) Social Security Numbers, Taxpayer Identification Numbers, Driver's License Numbers, Passport Numbers or Any Other Personal Identifying Numbers.** If it is necessary to include personal identifying numbers in a document, the parties should utilize some other identifier. Parties shall not include any portion of a social security number in a filing.
