MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME



On December 22, 2016, counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Marvin Williams with the Court of Appeals. On December 15, 2016, counsel had an oral argument in the case of The State v. Tiphani Parkhurst before this Court. On December 14, 2016, counsel had an oral argument in the case of The State v. Stepheno Alston before this Court. On December 9, 2016, counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Troy Wright v. The State with this Court.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.

5. Counsel for the Attorney General's office has been informed of this request.




