


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## ORDER


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Respondent moves this Court to strike appellant's designation of matter to be included in the record on appeal and appellant's initial brief. In the alternative, respondent requests this Court strike Item 14 from appellant's designation of matter and footnote 2 on page 25 of appellant's initial brief. Appellant has filed a return in opposition to the motion, to which respondent filed a reply. We agree with respondent that Item 14 and footnote 2 should be stricken. *See* Rules 209(b) and 210(c), SCACR; Rule 201(b), SCRE. However, we deny respondent's motion to strike the designation of matter and initial brief in their entirety. Instead, Item 14 is considered stricken from the designation of matter and shall not appear in the record on appeal, and footnote 2 of appellant's initial brief is considered stricken and shall not appear in appellant's final brief. Respondent's initial brief and designation of matter to be included in the record on appeal shall be served and filed within thirty days of the date of this order.
