ORDER

This case was dismissed due to Appellant's failure to serve and file a second amended record on appeal as required by this court's October 25, 2016 order. Appellant has filed a petition for rehearing. This court takes the opportunity to clarify that although Appellant requested this court to "place substitutions" in the record, this court is not able to do that for Appellant. As noted in this court's previous order, Appellant is required to make the required substitutions himself and serve and file a second amended record on appeal. Within twenty days of the date of this order, Appellant shall serve the second amended record on appeal that includes the correct and full matters designated by both parties. This court will act on the petition for rehearing upon receipt of the amended record on appeal or the expiration of twenty days, whichever occurs first.
