Dear Mr. Shearouse:

Yesterday I filed a Motion to be Relieved as Counsel in the above captioned PCR appeal. Today I received word from Sharon Graham at SCCID that the client's Affidavit of Indigency neglects to answer one necessary question. I am sending the client another form affidavit, and am asking that he execute it, *including* the question omitted in his last attempt, as soon as possible. I realize that the Court previously extended my deadline for ordering the PCR transcript to November 17<sup>th</sup>.
