Pursuant to South Carolina Appellate Rule (SCAPR) 221, Appellant Molly Morpew recently submitted a petition to the Court of Appeals requesting a rehearing on its Decision released January 11<sup>th</sup>, 2017 ("Decision"). Appellants Ferro did not submit a Petition for Rehearing, nor were included in the previous Petition.


It's been 4+ years since the case started, and 2+ years since Appellants Morpew and Appellants Ferro had appealed the lower court's Order for Specific Performance of November 2014. In the interim, the sellers, Appellants Ferro have found themselves under dangerous

economic stress and emotional distress. In order not to cause an innocent party further harm or damages, Appellant Morphew has agreed to withdraw any further continuances of the appeal for Specific Performance. Morphew would like to respectfully make clear to the lower court and to this court, that this is neither an agreement with the Courts' rulings nor an acquiescence in favor of the Defendants Dudek and Cross, but instead agreed to as a matter of 'what is right' as to as not cause any further harm than what has been caused the Ferros.

### CONCLUSION

For the reasons set forth herein this Motion, and governed under Rule 240, Motions and Petitions Generally, Morphew regrettably and most respectfully requests the Court to dismiss its Petition for Rehearing.




