





THE PROBATION AGENT: Antwan Adams.

THE CLERK: Do you swear or affirm to tell the truth, the whole truth, and nothing but the truth, so help you God?

THE DEFENDANT: Yes.

THE COURT: All right. Sir, do you have an attorney?

THE DEFENDANT: No, ma'am.

THE COURT: Would you like to have an attorney?

THE DEFENDANT: Yes, ma'am.

THE COURT: Sir?

THE DEFENDANT: Yes, ma'am.

THE COURT: And have you been screened for the Public Defender?

THE DEFENDANT: No, ma'am.

THE COURT: Go have a seat and one of the attorneys will speak with you.

(Pause.)

\*\*\*\*\*

THE PROBATION AGENT: Thank you, Your Honor. May it please the Court? Antwan Adams is under supervision for the offense of use of vehicle without permission with intent to deprive. He was

1 sentenced on 11/8/2010. His ending date was set to  
2 be 11/7/2012. He was given three years YOA,  
3 suspended to two years' probation, probation to  
4 terminate upon payment.

5 He was served with a citation on  
6 November 15th, 2011, at which time he stopped  
7 reporting. And that is why there is a warrant. So  
8 we are actually here for a citation and a warrant  
9 today.

10 On the citation, he failed to report on  
11 December 6, 2011, or any report thereafter. He  
12 failed to notify -- I'm sorry, that is the warrant  
13 that I'm talking about right now. It was written  
14 because he failed to report on December 6, 2011, or  
15 any report thereafter. He failed to notify his  
16 agent of his address change. Failed to notify  
17 agent of contact with law enforcement. He was  
18 arrested for forgery on May 16, 2012, by Lexington  
19 County Sheriff's Department. He failed to pay any  
20 of his accounts with -- as far as Dacor he still  
21 owes a balance of \$2,160.00. The only thing he has  
22 paid on is supervision, which is \$50. So he still  
23 owes his drug test fee and two court fines.

24 And then on the citation, he failed to report  
25 August 2nd, 2011, or any report thereafter. Failed

1 to gain consent to move, once again. He actually  
2 moved that time to Charleston County, by his own  
3 admission to his agent. Failed to refrain from the  
4 use of controlled substances by testing positive  
5 for marijuana on 11/8/2011. And again failing to  
6 pay the supervision fees, restitution, and court  
7 fines.

8 THE COURT: All right.

9 MR. SHIPMAN: Thank you, Your Honor. May it  
10 please the Court?

11 Mr. Adams is 26 years old. He has got two  
12 children, ages two and one. Their mother is  
13 currently doing an active sentence. I believe she  
14 is projected to be released next October -- or is  
15 it this October?

16 THE DEFENDANT: Next October.

17 MR. SHIPMAN: Next October. Those children  
18 are currently staying with their -- or her aunt,  
19 and he is also helping care for the children as  
20 well.

21 He was arrested in Georgia -- I think this was  
22 when the warrant was served on him -- on  
23 December 9th. He was incarcerated from  
24 December 9th until the March 29th. So he has got  
25 about three months and a half or so, or three

1 months and two-thirds. He is on a YOA probation,  
2 Your Honor. We would just ask that you convert  
3 that to an adult sentence and revoke in an amount  
4 of the time that he has served.

5 His pastor is also here from New Beulah  
6 Church. I have been speaking with him briefly.

7 Mr. Adams has just started a job at Hardee's.  
8 I think he started last Tuesday. He has also been  
9 active in the church. And he is going to ministry  
10 school, so he is trying to, I think, turn over a  
11 new leaf in his life.

12 I believe Pastor Bell would like to address  
13 you, if you see fit. And I don't know  
14 if Mr. Adams -- would you like to address her or  
15 not?

16 THE DEFENDANT: Yes, ma'am.

17 MR. SHIPMAN: And so they both would like to  
18 address you at the appropriate time, if you see  
19 fit, Your Honor.

20 THE COURT: What is he going to do about his  
21 restitution? How much money do you have to pay on  
22 your restitution?

23 MR. SHIPMAN: I'm not certain of the dollar  
24 amount, but the pastor did say that the church was  
25 willing to help him with the restitution.

1 THE COURT: No, how much does he have to pay?  
2 How much does he have today?

3 THE DEFENDANT: No, ma'am, I just started  
4 working last week. I got \$30 on me.

5 THE COURT: Has he picked up new charges?

6 THE PROBATION AGENT: Other than the two that  
7 he failed to notify Agent Smith of. The forgery in  
8 May of 2012, I think that is the only one -- that  
9 we know of, at least.

10 MR. SHIPMAN: Your Honor, I don't know what  
11 the disposition of that charge was. Mr. Adams says  
12 that nothing came of it, but I haven't verified  
13 that myself, Your Honor. And he was arrested in  
14 Georgia. However, those charges have been dropped  
15 when he was transported to South Carolina.

16 THE PROBATION AGENT: Yes, there is nothing on  
17 the rap sheet showing a conviction or a dismissal  
18 or anything for that forgery.

19 THE COURT: Okay. I will be glad to hear from  
20 anybody.

21 MR. SHIPMAN: Pastor Bell, would you like to  
22 address the Court?

23 MR. BELL: Do I need to come down there to  
24 talk?

25 MR. SHIPMAN: Your Honor, would you like --

1 THE COURT: As long as I can hear you.

2 MR. BELL: With the fee, I can pay something  
3 tomorrow morning, like maybe around \$400 for him,  
4 if he have to pay the fee.

5 THE COURT: All right. Thank you, sir.

6 How much is the restitution, \$2,160.00?

7 THE PROBATION AGENT: Yes, ma'am.

8 THE COURT: All right, this is what I am going  
9 to do. I am going to revoke six months, suspended  
10 upon payment of \$2,160.00 within 120 days. During  
11 that time, six months, he still needs to report.  
12 If he has any missed reports, he is to -- a bench  
13 warrant should be issued for his arrest. And he  
14 needs to be brought back before the Court. You can  
15 bring him back before me. And once he pays the  
16 money, the case can terminate. And convert the  
17 fees and fines to a civil judgment.

18 Sir, you understand that during the time  
19 period that I am giving you -- I said six months...  
20 120 days -- during the time period that you have to  
21 pay that money, you are to report to probation. If  
22 you do not report, they are going to issue a bench  
23 warrant for you. Do you understand that, sir?

24 THE DEFENDANT: Yes, ma'am.

25 THE COURT: All right. You have to come up

1 with \$2,160.00 within 120 days. If you do not do  
2 that, sir, you will have six months in jail. Do  
3 you understand that?

4 THE DEFENDANT: Yes, ma'am.

5 THE COURT: All right.

6 MR. SHIPMAN: Thank you, Your Honor.

7 THE COURT: And you can waive the fees,  
8 because I want him to pay restitution.

9 MS. DAIS: Your Honor, may it please the  
10 Court?
