MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME
IN WHICH TO FILE THE INITIAL BRIEF OF APPELLANT
AND DESIGNATION OF MATTER

Counsel for Aaron Young, Sr respectfully requests an extension of **final thirty (30) days, until March 13, 2017**, in which to file the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a fourth request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The initial brief of appellant and designation of matter are due to be filed with the Court today. The Court has granted counsel three previous extensions.
2. Counsel for Aaron Young, Sr., respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the number of extensions

Counsel filed the Petition for Writ of Certiorari with this Court in the case of Shanna Kranchick v. The State of South Carolina with the Supreme Court on January 11, 2017. Counsel filed the Initial Brief of Appellant in the case of The State of South Carolina v. James Bubba Patterson with this Court on January 9, 2017. Counsel filed the Brief of Petitioner in the case of Jason Sanford v. The State of South Carolina with the Supreme Court on January 3, 2017. Counsel filed the Brief of Appellant in the case of The State v. Lester Mosley, Jr. with this Court on December 19, 2016. Counsel filed the Initial Brief of Appellant in the case of The State of South Carolina v. Jermaine D. Grier with this Court on December 16, 2016.




5. Counsel for the Attorney General's office consents to this request shown by signature below.


